The U.S. Census Bureau has recently released Guam's 2010 Population counts. As of April 1, 2010, Guam's population totaled 159,358, representing an increase of 2.9 percent from the 2000 Census counts, or 154,805 persons. Additionally, the Census Bureau released population counts for the villages. In 2010, the municipalities of Mongmong-Toto-Maite, Chalan Pago-Ordot, and Mangilao showed the highest population increase since 2000 while the southern villages of Inarajan, Umatac, Agat and Merizo revealed a population decline.

More detailed information on Guam's population and housing characteristics is expected for release in spring of 2012 in the demographic profile. Guam's Demographic Profile will give a snapshot of selected demographic, social, economic and housing characteristics.
